
Right Whale Anatomy & Characteristics Answer Key



The pectoral flippers and tail flukes of whales are important to their survival. Tail flukes move up and down and help propel whales through the water. Their

flippers help them steer left and right. If a right whale's tail or flippers are injured, it could affect how it swims, finds food, and whether or not it survives.
